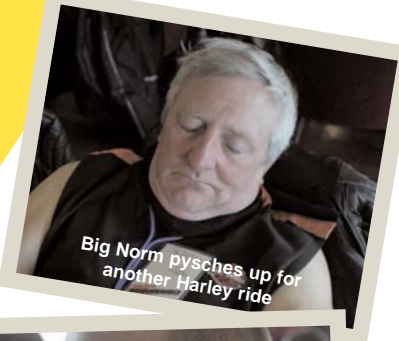
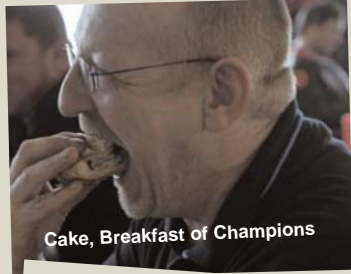

"So who's definitely doing it next year?"

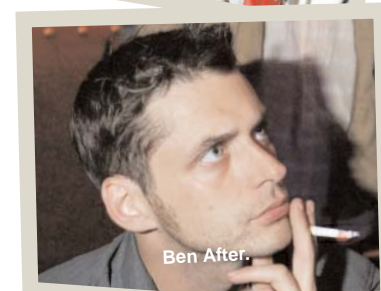
"Does a bear shit in the forest?"

"Honestly, listen to you girls...R1 this, K5 that, diablos, corsas, rear sets, power, handling, weight...whats all that about??"

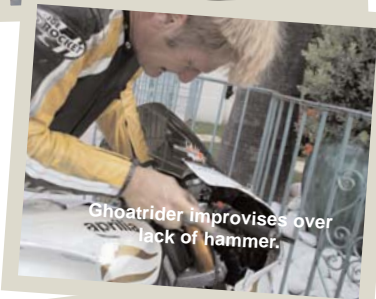

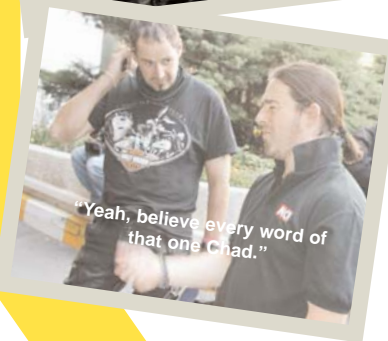
